Arabic, transliteration, meanings and references in journey order. This is not a compulsory script: no fixed prayer is assigned to each Tawaf circuit, the first sight of the Kaaba or completion of Umrah.

Dua for Leaving the House

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ، تَوَكَّلْتُ عَلَى اللَّهِ، لَا حَوْلَ وَلَا قُوَّةَ إِلَّا بِاللَّهِ

Transliteration: Bismillahi, tawakkaltu 'alallah, la hawla wa la quwwata illa billah.

Meaning: In the name of Allah, I place my trust in Allah. There is no might and no power except through Allah.

Dua for Boarding and Travel

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ، اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ. سُبْحَانَ الَّذِي سَخَّرَ لَنَا هَذَا وَمَا كُنَّا لَهُ مُقْرِنِينَ، وَإِنَّا إِلَى رَبِّنَا لَمُنْقَلِبُونَ. اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّا نَسْأَلُكَ فِي سَفَرِنَا هَذَا الْبِرَّ وَالْتَقْوَى، وَمِنَ الْعَمَلِ مَا تَرْضَى. اللَّهُمَّ هَوِّنْ عَلَيْنَا سَفَرَنَا هَذَا وَاطْوِ عَنَّا بُعْدَهُ. اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ الصَّاحِبُ فِي السَّفَرِ، وَالْخَلِيفَةُ فِي الْأَهْلِ. اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ وَعَثَاءِ السَّفَرِ، وَكَآبَةِ الْمَنْظَرِ، وَسُوءِ الْمُنْقَلَبِ فِي الْمَالِ وَالْأَهْلِ

Transliteration: Allahu akbar, Allahu akbar, Allahu akbar. Subhanalladhi sakhkhara lana hadha wa ma kunna lahu muqrinin, wa inna ila Rabbina lamunqalibun. Allahumma inna nas'aluka fi safarina hadha al-birra wat-taqwa, wa minal-'amali ma tarda.

Allahumma hawwin 'alayna safarana hadha watwi 'anna bu'dah. Allahumma Antas-sahibu fis-safar, wal-khalifatu fil-ahl. Allahumma inni a'udhu bika min wa'tha'is-safar, wa ka'abatil-manzar, wa su'il-munqalabi fil-mali wal-ahl.

Meaning: Allah is the Greatest. Glory be to the One Who has placed this transport at our service, though we could not have controlled it ourselves, and to our Lord we will return. O Allah, we ask You on this journey for goodness, mindfulness of You and deeds that please You.

Make this journey easy and shorten its distance. You are the Companion on the journey and the Guardian of the family. I seek Your protection from the hardship of travel, a distressing sight and a bad return in wealth or family.

Declaring Umrah

لَبَّيْكَ عُمْرَةً

Transliteration: Labbayka 'umratan.

Meaning: Here I am for Umrah.

Reference and status: The importance of intention is established in [Sahih al-Bukhari 1](#). This short declaration identifies the rite; it is not presented here as a compulsory formula quoted from that narration.

The Talbiyah with Meaning

لَبَّيْكَ اللَّهُمَّ لَبَّيْكَ، لَبَّيْكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ لَبَّيْكَ، إِنَّ الْحَمْدَ وَالنِّعْمَةَ لَكَ وَالْمُلْكُ،
لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ

Transliteration: Labbayka Allahumma labbayk. Labbayka la sharika laka labbayk. Innal-hamda wan-ni'mata laka wal-mulk, la sharika lak.

Meaning: Here I am, O Allah, here I am. Here I am; You have no partner, here I am.

All praise, blessing and sovereignty belong to You. You have no partner.

Dua When Entering Masjid al-Haram

اللَّهُمَّ افْتَحْ لِي أَبْوَابَ رَحْمَتِكَ

Transliteration: Allahumma-ftah li abwaba rahmatik.

Meaning: O Allah, open for me the doors of Your mercy.

At the Black Stone at the Start of Each Circuit

اللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ

Transliteration: Allahu Akbar.

Meaning: Allah is the Greatest.

Between the Yemeni Corner and the Black Stone

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

Transliteration: Rabbana atina fid-dunya hasanatan wa fil-akhirati hasanatan wa qina 'adhaban-nar.

Meaning: Our Lord, grant us good in this world and good in the Hereafter, and protect us from the punishment of the Fire.

What Should You Do at Maqam Ibrahim After Tawaf?

وَاتَّخِذُوا مِنْ مَّقَامِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ مُصَلًّى

Transliteration: Wattakhidhu min maqami Ibrahima musalla.

Meaning: Take the standing-place of Abraham as a place of prayer.

Dua for Drinking Zamzam Water

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ عِلْمًا نَافِعًا، وَرِزْقًا وَاسِعًا، وَشِفَاءً مِنْ كُلِّ دَاءٍ

Transliteration: Allahumma inni as'aluka 'ilman nafi'an, wa rizqan wasi'an, wa shifa'an min kulli da'.

Meaning: O Allah, I ask You for beneficial knowledge, abundant provision and healing from every illness.

Reference and status: [Ibn Majah 3062](#) concerns the intention in drinking Zamzam; it does not contain this wording. You may use the words above as a personal request, without attributing them here to a fixed Prophetic practice.

What to Read When Approaching Safa

إِنَّ الصَّفَا وَالْمَرْوَةَ مِنْ شَعَائِرِ اللَّهِ

Transliteration: Innas-Safa wal-Marwata min sha'a'irillah.

Meaning: Indeed, Safa and Marwah are among the symbols of Allah.

What to Read When Approaching Safa

أَبْدَأُ بِمَا بَدَأَ اللَّهُ بِهِ

Transliteration: Abda'u bima bada' Allahu bihi.

Meaning: I begin with what Allah began with.

Reference: [Sahih Muslim 1218a](#), in Jabir's account of approaching Safa.

Dhikr at Safa and Marwah

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ. لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ، أَنْجَزَ وَعْدَهُ، وَنَصَرَ عَبْدَهُ، وَهَزَمَ الْأَحْزَابَ وَحْدَهُ

Transliteration: La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lah, lahul-mulku wa lahul-hamdu wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir. La ilaha illallahu wahdah, anjaza wa'dah, wa nasara 'abdah, wa hazamal-ahzaba wahdah.

Meaning: None has the right to be worshipped except Allah alone, with no partner. His is the sovereignty and praise, and He has power over everything.

None has the right to be worshipped except Allah alone. He fulfilled His promise, helped His servant and defeated the confederates alone.

Face the qiblah where possible, recite the dhikr and make personal dua; repeat the sequence three times. Do likewise at Marwah.

Is There a Dua After Completing Umrah?

رَبَّنَا تَقَبَّلْ مِنَّا إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ

Transliteration: Rabbana taqabbal minna innaka Antas-Sami'ul-'Alim.

Meaning: Our Lord, accept from us. You are indeed the All-Hearing, All-Knowing.

Reference: [Quran 2:127](#). This is a general Quranic dua for acceptance, not a formula assigned specifically to the end of Umrah.

Dua for Your Parents

رَبِّ ارْحَمْهُمَا كَمَا رَبَّيَانِي صَغِيرًا

Transliteration: Rabbir-hamhuma kama rabbayani saghira.

Meaning: My Lord, have mercy upon them as they raised me when I was small.

Dua for Your Parents

رَبَّنَا اغْفِرْ لِي وَلِوَالِدَيَّ وَلِلْمُؤْمِنِينَ يَوْمَ يَقُومُ الْحِسَابُ

Transliteration: Rabbana-ghfir li wa liwalidayya wa lil-mu'minina yawma yaqumul-hisab.

Meaning: Our Lord, forgive me, my parents and the believers on the day the reckoning takes place.

Sayyid al-Istighfar: A Comprehensive Prayer for Forgiveness

اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ، خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكَ، وَأَنَا عَلَى عَهْدِكَ
وَوَعْدِكَ مَا اسْتَطَعْتُ، أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتُ، أَبُوءُ لَكَ بِنِعْمَتِكَ
عَلَيَّ، وَأَبُوءُ لَكَ بِذَنْبِي، فَاغْفِرْ لِي، فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذُّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

Transliteration: Allahumma Anta Rabbi la ilaha illa Anta, khalaqtani wa ana 'abduka, wa ana 'ala 'ahdika wa wa'dika mastata'tu. A'udhu bika min sharri ma sana'tu. Abu'u laka bini'matika 'alayya, wa abu'u laka bidhanbi, faghfir li, fa innahu la yaghfirudh-dhunuba illa Anta.

Meaning: O Allah, You are my Lord. None has the right to be worshipped except You. You created me and I am Your servant.

I remain faithful to Your covenant and promise as much as I can. I seek refuge in You from the evil of what I have done. I acknowledge Your blessing upon me and admit my sin, so forgive me, for none forgives sins except You.

Dua for Guidance

اللَّهُمَّ اهْدِنِي وَسَلِّدْنِي

Transliteration: Allahumma-hdini wa saddidni.

Meaning: O Allah, guide me and keep me on the straight course.
